Students continue to struggle with multi-step word problems and completing all steps of the word problem.

NC Checkins are more rigorous than NHCS Benchmarks have been in the past.

Word problems are both multi-step and multi-operational. We need to include this type of word problems for instruction.

Progress monitoring completion report-

Teachers including PM as part of instruction, being creative with pulling and assessing will more likely use data to change targeted small group instruction.

Systematic progress monitoring raises teacher concern about students' reading progress and to signal the need for additional or different forms of instruction.

Our intensive students need the most targeted skills but their PM %'s are the lowest. Most measures are 1 minute in Grades K-2 DIBELS. TRC PM is 1 book. Teachers want to see how their students are responding to instruction. PM is crucial.
